Project Background

Maersk, a global leader in logistics, recognised the need to modernize its headquarters in Rotterdam to better support a new, flexible, and task-oriented work culture. The existing office was outdated, characterized by traditional furnishings and separate spaces. To foster a more dynamic and efficient working environment, Maersk embarked on a comprehensive renovation project with key goals focused on:

Flexibility: Creating adaptable workspaces to accommodate various tasks and work styles.

Sustainability: Implementing eco-friendly solutions to reduce environmental impact.

Ease of Use: Ensuring that the new office setup is user-friendly and intuitive.

Ergonomics: Enhancing employee comfort and well-being through ergonomic furniture and equipment.

Future-oriented: Designing a workspace that is scalable and can adapt to future needs.



Products/Solution

To meet these goals, Maersk integrated several innovative products:

Galaxy Dual Monitor Arm with Static Arms and VESA Slider: This solution provides flexibility for dual-screen setups, allowing for easy adjustment and positioning.

Desk Up 1.0 Power Solution: Mounted on the pole of the Galaxy monitor arm, this power solution offers convenient access to power right at the workstation.

Power Blocks Underneath the Desk: These provide additional power outlets, keeping cables organized and out of sight.

Comprehensive Power Cabling: Ensuring seamless power delivery from the building infrastructure to each individual workspace and ensuring structured cable management.
